The Benevolent Society (Benevolent) will transition its disability therapy and positive behavioural support services to the Australian Health & Therapy Group (AHTG), a leading provider specialising in delivering disability-focused therapy.

AHTG is a strong group of therapy organisations including Therapy Pro, Adaptability Therapy, and Tashacare Australia.

Benevolent's disability therapy and positive behavioural support services will transition with all current teams and leadership structures intact to become a new organisation known as Avina - the fourth brand in the AHTG family.

Following a thorough evaluation of the best support model for clients, it was determined that transferring these services to AHTG would enhance service delivery, strengthen clinical outcomes, and deliver greater long-term benefits for the people we support and their families.

As a group committed exclusively to high-quality disability therapy, AHTG is well-positioned to support Avina, continuing and expanding the exceptional care Benevolent has provided.

AHTG's therapy brands have received numerous awards for service excellence, including Therapy Pro's recognition as Best Early Intervention Program at the Australian Disability Service Awards in 2021, 2022, and 2023.

With the addition of Benevolent's disability therapy and positive behavioural support services, AHTG will expand its presence across New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, and South Australia, employing more than 400 therapists.

Benevolent is committed to ensuring a seamless transition for clients and staff. The disability services team will remain essentially unchanged, with Benevolent therapists taking up the opportunity to transfer to Avina, so that therapy and behaviour support services can continue to be delivered at the same locations by the same dedicated professionals.

The transition will be finalised on 15 June 2025.
